### CONTINUING EDUCATION - EFT

Our presenter will be Ann Smith from Bloomington, IN instructing us in Level I and II of EFT or Emotional Freedom Technique (Tapping). Her website is [insideoutwitheft.com](http://insideoutwitheft.com). Level I will give 6 hours CEUs and Level II will give us 12 CEUs which includes 8 hours on Saturday and 4 hours on Sunday.

No discount on one day attendance. You do not HAVE to take level I and Level II at this convention; however, you may not take Level II without first taking Level I. We cannot accept payments on the Registration fees. No refunds.

### LUNCH ON FRIDAY, SATURDAY AND SUNDAY
